## Dvar Torah

In last Weeks Parsha (Vayeshev) we have the episode of Yosef being sent by Yakov Avinu to find his brothers. Malach Gavriel saw Yosef searching and he asked him "what are you looking for?" Yosef replied " Es achai ani mivakesh. " My brothers I do seek. " Gavriel told Yosef "They have traveled from here."

Rashi comments that "they have traveled from here" refers to Gavriel hinting to Yosef that his brothers have traveled away from brotherhood and no longer counted Yosef among them. My grandfather Rabbi Avraham Halevi Jungreis ZT"L (Yahrzeit this week) said that this Pasuk of Es Achai Anochi Mivakesh should be the motto of every Jew. Even if your brother has traveled away from brotherhood you must go out and seek him.

The Menorah is lit in such a public display so that anybody walking by when they glance at the Menorah will be able to appreciate the greatness of the Nes in an obvious manner. As this is the fulfillment of the mitzvah of "Pirsumei Nisa" (public display of the miracle). Persumei Nisa is a prerequisite to the Mitzvah of Chanukah Lecht.

Can we fulfill our mission on this world with our own Persumai Nisa? Each of us has been endowed with a special Neshoma. It is our duty to bring forth its light in a manner of Persumai Nisa while there are people in the "marketplace". As the mitzvah is that the Menorah should be lit while everyone is in the marketplace. This world is our marketplace, We can all offer the ohr of our Neshomas to those around us. Our one light can be a spark and be the light to many. May we light the Neshoma of all those around us and may we be Zoche to the great Persumai Nisa that will occur when lighting the Menorah in Bais Mikdash Hashlishi. By Tzvi Hirsh Jungreis.
