Dvar Torah

This weeks parasha tells us that when the Jews were on their way out of Mitzrayim, Moshe Rabbainu took the bones of Yosef "imo - with him." The commentators asks, why was Moshe Rabbainu, the one who had the sole responsibility of an entire nation and all their tasks, the one who took Yosef's bones out of Mitzrayim? Seemingly, someone else or a different group of people should have been the ones responsible to unbury Yosef and bring his bones to Eretz Yisrael. Perhaps someone who had nothing else on his mind other than this task, should have been the one to carry out this deed. The answer is, Moshe Rabbainu knew b'ruach hakodesh that the Jewish people were going to be a stubborn nation who would complain every step of the way. As we see only a few psukim into this weeks parasha the Jews turn to Moshe and say, "We would have been better being slaves in Egypt than to die in the wilderness!" Moshe Rabbainu knew that this was only the first of many claims that the Jews would have during their time in the desert. Therefore Moshe Rabbainu himself took the bones of Yosef and carried them specifically with him through the 40 years in the desert to remind himself of Yosef's story. Every time Moshe Rabbainu would see Yosef's bones in his tent he would imagine Yosef saying to him, "my brothers wronged me for 22 years. They sold me to slavery, yet I never held a grudge against them." Through the bones of Yosef, Moshe Rabbainu would remember no matter what claims the Jewish people might have against him, he should always remember he's doing the word of HaShem and to not hold a grudge against the Jewish people. *Dvar Torah by Roey Malul accredited to Rabbi Mansour.*
