Dvar Torah

How is the changing of Jacob's name after requesting a blessing from the Angel that he had fought with going to serve as the blessing that he so desired? We perhaps can say that this statement of him keeping the 613 Mitzvos was meant to scare Esau, as he was proclaiming that no matter what you do me, I will always prevail, because I have my mind in the right place at all times, even by Lavan. Now the verse states that "Jacob was left alone" and that is when he had gotten attacked. The reality is, that specifically when we feel "alone" in this world, when we have lost some of our strengths, that is when the Satan steps in with his full power. When that happens, we get confused, as we had only thought that this certain moment was in a scenario of something "small" (such as Jacob retrieving the "small" possessions he had forgotten). As Hashem is telling us that no matter how small the matter is, it is always big. However, Jacob and all of us have an advantage, that we are looking for blessings from Hashem ALL THE TIME. That is why the Angel said, "Let me go, for dawn is breaking". As with that holy mindset, all darkness goes away and gives room for light. The magnitude of fighting with such a belief is to the point that you also have a whole new name and identity! As you are no longer controlled by another force, you are controlled by YOU. 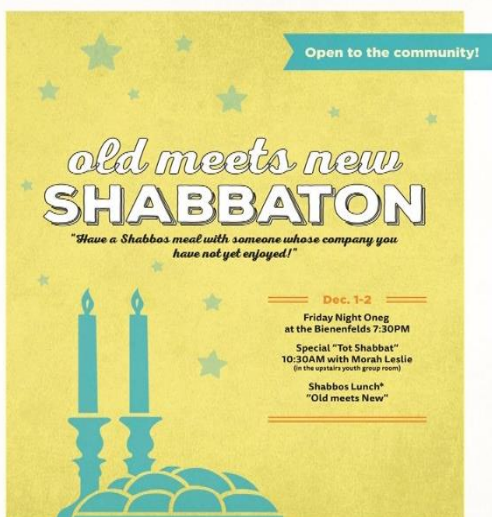
