Dvar Torah: Moshe Raskind

After Sara dies and Avraham buries her, He sets out to find a bride for his son Isaac. He sends his trusted friend and servant, Eliezer to his family to find a wife for Isaac, a wife having the same qualities as his late wife. Sara was known for her beauty, her deep emotion and intelligence.

He brought 3 gifts, a nose ring and two bracelets. The nose ring attaches to the head which is the repository of intellect (Seichel). The identical bracelets symbolize both the body (guf) and the emotion (nefesh). Rivkah personified the three aspects that Sara had. She was smart, beautiful and empathetic.

Another explanation of the gifts is that the bracelets were equivalent to the luchot. Two tablets, two bracelets identical in value. The nose ring, according to Rashi, weighed ½ shekel, the same amount that future Jews would bring to the Holy Temple. It would take Jews contributing their share with others to create the sense of community.

Today, we at Young Israel have continued the tradition. Our community efforts made it possible to purchase the new building which we shall all dedicate and sanctify to Hashem.
