(They died.)

To be more precise, according to the Midrash, their actual response was, "The city is filled with laughter, song and happiness; how can you say it will be overturned?"

Rav Henoch Leibowitz zt"l extracted a powerful lesson in human psychology from this response. If you look at it, Lot's sons in law were not saying 'We don't believe in Hashem and His power to destroy Sodom!' All they said was 'Look how wonderful things are!' (and so Hashem would never do it). But what does that have to do with anything?

Rav Leibowitz said, this had to have been an emotional response, not a logical one. We human beings have a weakness in that we have a hard time with 'change'. When things are going a certain way- whether for good OR for bad- we emotionally become lulled into the feeling of 'This is the status quo'. How easy it is to forget that really it's Hashem Who's running the show from moment to moment, and one moment does not reflect on what Hashem will decide the next.

The lesson for us is: In good times, to be grateful to Hashem for all He bestows upon us, and in dark times "l", to be optimistic for a better future, hopeful for Hashem's salvation that comes 'in the blink of an eye'.
