Dvar Torah

In the עשרת הדברות we are commanded “Don’t desire” [what someone else has]

The אבן עזרא asks— How is it possible to control our feelings of desire? The אבן עזרא explains that when we realize that the potential object of our desire has no relevance to us, then we won’t desire it. Examples- we have no real desire to fly like a bird since we are not a bird and realize that flying is simply not relevant to us. Similarly if we would think and therefore feel that Hashem gives us only exactly what we need for our שלימות, then we won't desire what another person has, because it has no relevance to us.. Another person's house, car, spouse, and job will not be the object of our desires if we work on internalizing this fundamental hashkafa.

Let's consider the following scenario - A fellow who is struggling financially goes back in time 150 yrs.... His “old” cell phone would earn him world acclaim. His old dilapidated car would be much faster than anyone’s fancy chariots being pulled by the finest horses. Yet currently this person feels like he is “struggling” and lacking - mainly because he compares himself to the people that have more than him. This comparison stops him from feeling his own comforts, but in reality he may be very comfortable. May we merit the strength of character to only focus on and appreciate the joys that Hashem granted us, without becoming distracted by another's circumstances. By Rabbi Chananya Kramer
