Young Israel has initiated its program of volunteer security greeters controlling the door, screening those seeking entry and conducting counter-surveillance on Shabbos mornings. Cherry Hill Police Department (CHPD) is offering to residents a **Citizens Police Academy**. The program will increase understanding of operational policies and procedures of CHPD and explore aspects of law enforcement. The program is open to any adult who lives in Cherry Hill and has no felony convictions or pending criminal actions at the time of application. It is an 8 week program meeting every Wednesday from 6:30-9:00 PM at the Cherry Hill Police Department. The program will run from April 1, 2020 until May 20, 2020. The class will meet on Tuesday April 7, 2020 instead of Wednesday April 8, 2020, due to Passover. Class size is limited to 30 people and there is no cost. Interested persons must complete an online application and return it to the CHPD to the attention of Sergeant Edward Walto, Program Coordinator or email the completed application to [CRU@cherryhillpolice.com](mailto:CRU@cherryhillpolice.com). Although this class does not involve tactical training. It is an excellent opportunity for civilians to better understand law enforcement and make themselves more able to understand and assist in security of the YICH community.
