Near the end of Noach we are introduced to Avraham. Nimrod throws Avraham into the furnace mainly because Avraham refused to worship Nimrod's idols and one of those idols was fire. Would Avraham's G-d save him or would Nimrod's god devour him? Haron, Avraham's brother, vacillated from supporting his brother and taking on his faith and succumbing to the idolatry and godlessness of the culture. When, Avraham survived the test, Haron decided to follow his brother. Haron was thrown into the same furnace and died.

Haron's death led his soul to be elevated and he became the progenitor of Rachel, Leah and David HaMelech. But this is not the only connection that Haron has to future tzaddikim. According to the Maharal, Aharon had the same soul as Haran. However, like the spelling of the names themselves, Haran lacked the Aleph. The Aleph, stands for chief, or leader. In death, Haran's soul had the Aleph added. He later became the first Cohen Gadol.
