On Shmini Atzeres we say חתפלת גשם prayer for rain. The sefarim say that really we should daven for rain at the beginning of Sukkos, but since rain would stop us from sitting in the Sukka we wait until Shmini Atzeres.

Besides for the obvious practical reason for this (the close proximity of Sukkos to the rainy season) is there maybe a deeper reason for the connection of מפלת גשם and Sukkos.

In the first Pasuk of this weeks Parsha, Moshe Rabbenu begins his song by calling upon the heavens and earth to listen to his words. Rashi explains that he was calling on them to be witnesses to his warning to
