On Shmini Atzeres we say תפלת גשם the prayer for rain. The sefarim say that really we should daven for rain at the beginning of Sukkos, but since rain would stop us from sitting in the Sukka we wait until Shmini Atzeres.

Besides for the obvious practical reason for this (the close proximity of Sukkos to the rainy season) is there maybe a deeper reason for the connection of תפלת גשם and Sukkos.

In the first Pasuk of this weeks Parsha, Moshe Rabbenu begins his song by calling upon the heavens and earth to listen to his words. Rashi explains that he was calling on them to be witnesses to his warning to the Jews. Since the heavens and earth are eternal the Jews can never deny that they were warned should a punishment befall them. Perhaps we could say we that since we sit in the Sukka under the Heavens and on top of the earth, showing that we are willing to leave the comfort of our homes to fulfill Hashems mitzvos. With this merit we pray for rain, the ultimate gift and Bracha.
