s Shabbos we read about Amalek and have of zechiras Amalek. The goal of this mitznind us to wipe out their memory and yet, en know exactly who they are. Furtherwant to wipe out their memory, wouldn't to stop discussing them altogether? To this mitzvah we need to understand what vith them.

en we came out of Mitzravim. Klal Yisrael g! We were on top of the world! The nations all realized that Hashem created the world and

appointed a people to be His nation, and WE were those people. Then suddenly, "Asher karcha ba'derech..." Amalek happened upon us. What does this language of "happened" imply? Their **entire** nature is happenstance. They can't stand a nation with a purpose. Our existence of purpose and meaning was too much for those who stand for coincidence and randomness. We still have a war in our minds called Milchemes Amalek. Every time we think a second of our lives is not divinely ordained Amalek is winning.

Chazal want us to understand this lesson before Purim when we read the Megillah, a seemingly mundane story, in which G-d is not mentioned and which occurred outside of Israel. We need to look at the story through the proper lenses, not those of coincidence, but those that allow us to view every second of our as being divinely ordained. Every second is a critical part of the story of my life, and every situation that I find myself in is given to me by a loving and caring Almighty Hashem. This is the perspective Chazal want us to have as we prepare for Purim. May we all internalize the message and chas v'shalom not live lives of happenstance, rather of connection to Hashem and one another.
