In this week's Parsha, there is an interesting anomaly in that Moshe Rabbeinu's name is not mentioned once throughout the parsha. This is the only time excluding Sefer Devarim that this is the case. Even more peculiar, Moshe's birthday and yahrtzeit always falls on this parsha reading. Why is this relevant?

According to the Ba'al HaTurim, Moshe's name was missing because Moshe tells Hashem that if Hashem would not forgive the Jewish people for the sin of the Golden Calf, Moshe wanted to be erased from the Torah. It says in Bereishis Rabbah, a curse of a sage, whether undeserved or made conditionally, will come to fruition. This means that the curse that Moshe announced was bound to occur. This explains the absence of Moshe's name.

But why this week's parsha? The Vilna Gaon concludes that because Moshe's yahrtzeit falls on the week of this parsha reading and disappeared from this world, so to his name "disappears" from Tetzaveh.

Let those two concepts sink in. The love that Moshe had for Klal Yisrael was tremendous. He knew that his curse would be executed and his name would disappear from the Torah. We, as Klal Yisrael can learn that it's not about receiving recognition, but demonstrating and actively showing our love for all of Klal Yisrael. Gutt Shabbas.
