Dvar Torah: Moshe Raskind

Ha'Azinu is mostly a poem, or song, written by Moshe Rabeinu. In the Parasha, Moshe reminds the people to look at the days of old. According to Shem MiShmuel, "This correspondence between the 70 souls of Yisrael and the 70 nations of the world, is very important to Jewish thought. Although today there are more than seventy nations, after the great Flood, 70 primary nations emerged. When the offspring of Yaacov were first considered a nation, there were 70 members of the family. The idea here is that each primary world nation corresponded to one root member of Klal Yisrael. If that member of the klal correctly and fully maximized his spiritual potential, he had the ability to rectify his corresponding nation."
