## Dvar Torah: Aaron Roller

This week's parsha marks a grave turning point in the Torah's narrative. Instead of swiftly journeying to Eretz Yisrael, with the fanfare of the trumpets and the sublime accompaniment of the Clouds of Glory, the Children of Israel were ultimately fated to wander for 40 years in the desert, while the entire generation died off. While the direct cause was the sin of the spies recounted in *Parshat Shlach*, the root in this week's *parsha* when *Bnei Yisrael* begin to complain. It is the lack of gratitude and the preoccupation with small trifles - missing cucumbers when there is manna descending from heaven daily - that marks the generation's inadequacy.

And yet, there are two other models of speaking up in this week's *parsha* that mark a sharp contrast to the complaining that dooms the generation. At the start of the *parsha*, when *Bnei Yisrael* celebrate *Pesach*, there are those who feel deprived of the ability to properly observe. Their sincere concern at missing out on the *mitzvah* of *korban Pesach* leads Moshe to bring their question before Hashem, leading to the institution of *Pesach Sheni*.

Then at the end of the *parsha*, after the prophetess Miriam is struck by *tzara'at* as punishment for the sin of evil speech, Moshe prays on her behalf. This concern for his sister is more impressive because Moshe himself was the victim of Miriam's *Lashon Hara*.

These instances of positive speech and correct priorities - focusing on *mitzvah* observance and overlooking slights in order to be sensitive to the needs of others - help to point the way for us to improve our speech and our actions.
