Dvar Torah: Moshe Raskind

The Paschal Lamb

Recalling how Hashem, with a strong arm led us out of Egypt from the bondage of slavery is something we do at least 2 different times of the year as well as daily in our prayers. Hashem commanded us to take a lamb,

an Egyptian deity, slaughter it and paint our doorways with its blood. This symbol would allow Hashem as he killed the first born of Egypt, to pass over the homes of the Jews keeping them safe from death.

Does not Hashem know who the Jews are and who are the Egyptians? Why did he need us to paint or mark our door ways with blood? Everyone inside the marked homes would be safe, including non-Jews. The bloody lintels were themselves an advertisement that this home is under special guard and that it is safe.

We must do our own diligence to keep ourselves safe. It is a partnership with God. He will do His part only if we do ours first. If a Jew did not mark his home with the blood of

the lamb, their home was not safe from the Angel of Death.

Sunday, Young Israel will have a security training for all to attend at 930 AM. A culture of safety and security will begin to be established. Some may wish to help by volunteering as "welcomers "at the door and others may just wish to attend to understand more of why we are developing

safety precautions and to help create an atmosphere of safety. So please, everyone the more participation the better.

Let us all work in partnership with Hashem to create a shul that is safe and secure; where davening to our creator can be done with total concentration.
